Andrea Sabillon is a project administrator with UnidosUS, the largest Hispanic civil rights and advocacy organization in the country. Sabillon provides daily support to the chief operating officer on a range of institutional and administrative duties, including on organizational strategy and efforts to engage UnidosUS community-based Affiliates. Prior to her joining the UnidosUS team, she was at the American Friends Service Committee where she was the legal assistant to the Friends Representation Initiative of New Jersey or FRINJ program. FRINJ is a pilot program that promotes the right to counsel in the detained immigration context. It is the second of its kind in the country, following the NYIFUP out of New York. Sabillon graduated magna cum laude from Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, with a bachelor of arts degree in political science. At Rutgers, she was an undergraduate associate at the Eagleton Institute of Politics and served as an AmeriCorps member with the Institute's Program on Immigration and Democracy. Andrea is bilingual in English and Spanish, and was born and raised in New Jersey.
